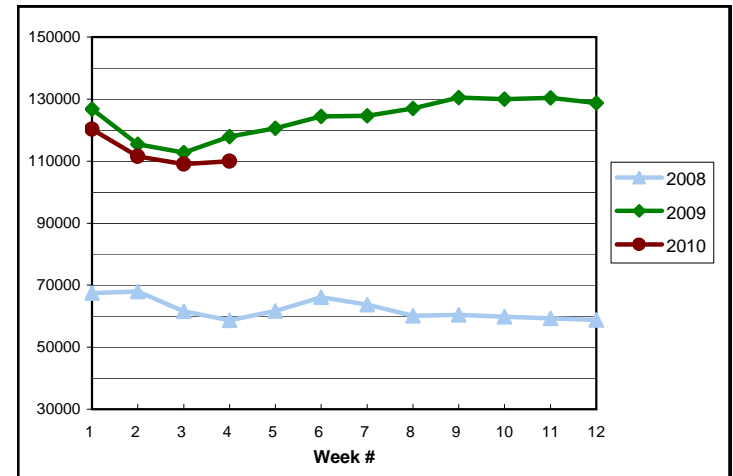

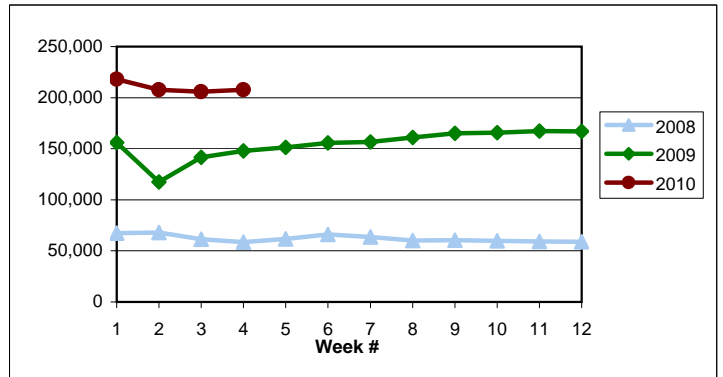

**Total: \$65,726,774**

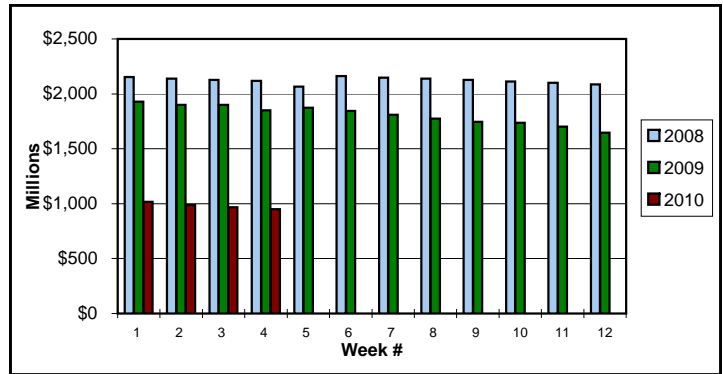
**Weeks Claimed - By Program**

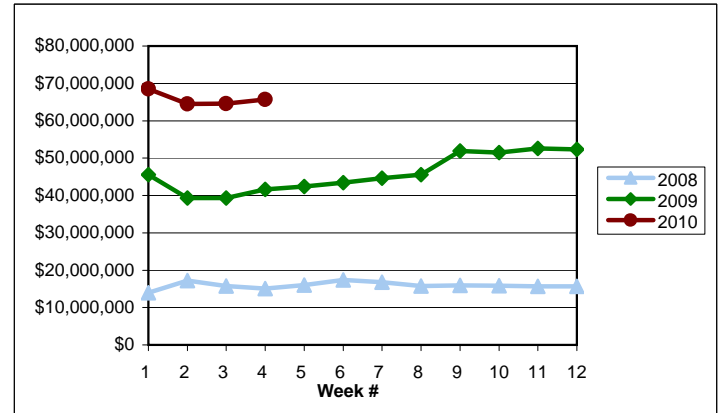
**Total Weeks Claimed (Regular + EB + EUC + OEB): 207,722**
