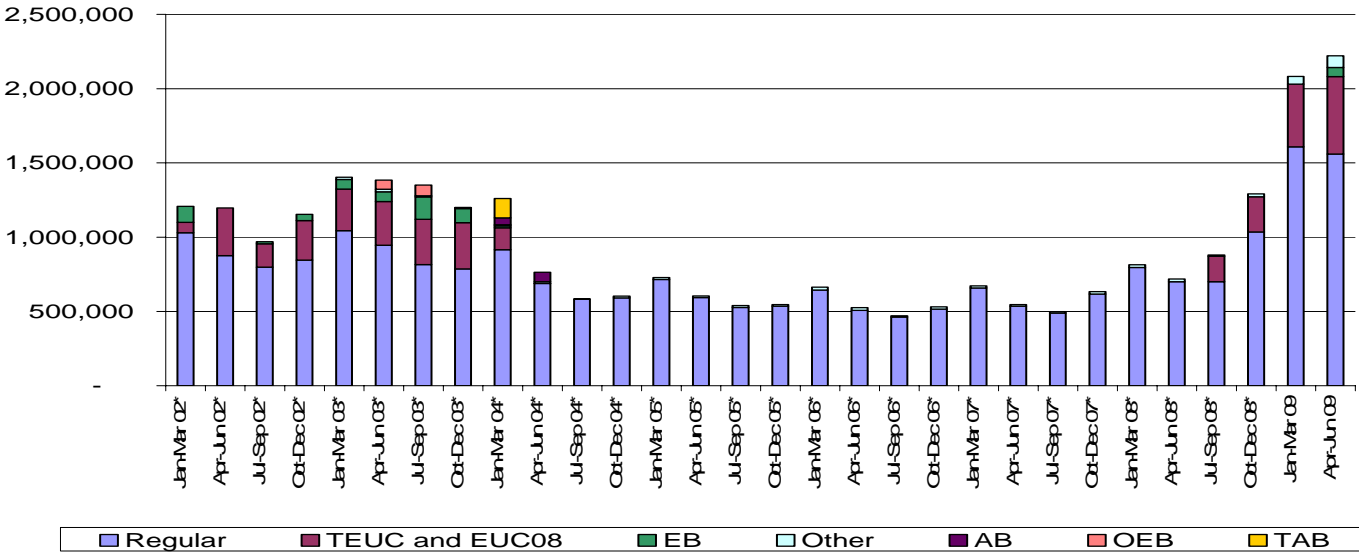
UI Program Information:
