ACTIONS TAKEN, MAJOR PROJECT UPDATES, AND OTHER MILESTONES

- The Tillamook Worksource Oregon office has placed several youth hires with the Tillamook School District, and is referring candidates for temporary summer youth positions with MTC (Management Training Corp).
- DHS ARRA-funded Human Services Specialist positions are listed for positions in the Roseburg, Madras, and Prineville.
- Several home weatherization technician positions are open through the Redmond Worksource Oregon office.
- Following the successful relationship with LKE in Klamath County, we are engaging with Just Bucket Excavating for recruiting project managers, heavy equipment operators, and laborers. Just Bucket is also involved with the floating island project on Lower Klamath Lake.
- Working with our WIA partners and Community Connections in Baker, Union, and Wallowa counties to offer budgeting classes. Information will cover: contacting creditors, getting a copy of your credit report, then followed by 1:1 assistance with a counselor.

UPCOMING PLANNED ACTIONS, MAJOR PROJECTS, DEADLINES, AND GRANT OPPORTUNITIES

- The Oregon Workforce Investment Board (OWIB) is planning to pursue a State Energy Sector Partnership grant (one of the green jobs grants from DOL). Discussions are underway to integrate current activities into the proposal, and to make the grant seamless with the Green Jobs Strategy the Legislature recently required from OWIB. The grant application is due October 20.
- The Workforce Investment Council of Clackamas County is looking at several grant opportunities funded under the Health Care and Emerging Industries grant opportunity. OED will be a partner on the Energy Training Partnership proposal, which would grant \$5 Million over a 3-year period to create certification and career pathways for new and incumbent workers in the renewable electric industry. The emphasis is on wind and solar. In addition to training, a strong on-the-job component is present. Region 15 would receive \$500,000 in this grant award.
- The Workforce Investment Council of Clackamas County (WICCO) is partnering with OHSU and OIT to work on a Health Care and Emerging Industries Sector grant. The range of the grant will be between \$2M and \$5M; the focus is on Health Informatics. The money will be used to expand opportunities for job seekers for educational opportunities at community colleges in this field, which is seen as an emerging career in the health care arena.
- Various options are under consideration for OED to partner to apply for a Health Care Sector/Emerging Industries grant. Grant applications are due October 5.
