ACTIONS TAKEN, MAJOR PROJECT UPDATES, AND OTHER MILESTONES

- Claimant Reemployment sessions continue to take place around the state, to assist claimants with iMatchSkills registration, skill review, and job search assistance.
- One employer who received ARRA funds through a U.S. Department of Energy grant had the following comments about the service he received:
 - “I wanted to thank you and your organization for the outstanding accommodations and personal services extended to us during our recruiting process. We were provided with excellent candidates.”
- The Worksource Oregon Eugene office is hosting claimant networking classes, giving job seekers a chance to cross collaborate in their job search activities.
- The Region 11 Worksource Oregon offices (Klamath and Lake counties) have enhanced their Claimant Reemployment Orientation process to include an initial skills review.

UPCOMING PLANNED ACTIONS, MAJOR PROJECTS, DEADLINES, AND GRANT OPPORTUNITIES

- Awaiting response on several grants that have been applied for:
 - Broadband for BES field office upgrade through Dept. of Commerce/NTIA. Awards were initially going to be announced starting November 7, but NTIA announced that this will be delayed to December.
 - Green Jobs Labor Market Information through Dept. of Labor – should be awarded prior to December
