- I-5: Shady Bridge
  - New SB bridge scheduled to open in September, with new SB ramps (and pedestrian bridge under SB I-5 bridge) opening in November
- Or 42: Hoover Hill
  - Currently paving new alignment, preparing to connect to highway by mid September
- US 101: Panorama to Thomas Creek Paving
  - Kissing Rock slide repair – complete
  - Paving on north section to begin next week
  - Guardrail work about 2/3 complete

**2012-15 STIP Project Prioritization- Lisa Cortes**

- Applications have been scored and prioritized so that we will be ready when the funding becomes available
- Applications that are not funded in the 2012-15 STIP can be resubmitted in the 2014-17 STIP
- Anticipated funding for our area will be \$1- 4 million
