RULE SUMMARY

The amendment of OAR 734-020-0005 adopts the 2009 Edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, Oregon Supplement to the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, and the Oregon Temporary Traffic Control Handbook as standards for traffic control devices in Oregon in accordance with ORS 810.200. The amended rule complies with federal requirements set forth in Title 23, United States Code, Section 109(d) and Title 23, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 655.603, which requires states to adopt the 2009 Edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices and any supplements within two years of issuance.

The amendment also recognizes the Traffic Control Devices Committee as the official advisory body to the State Traffic Engineer on uniform standards for traffic control devices in this state, and repeals OAR 734-020-0055 because it is covered in the referenced documents of OAR 734-020-0005.
